

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Monday, July 6, 2026 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Chris Kreutzer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Kreutzer asked City Clerk Jeannine Hassell for Roll Call; Council President Derek Meyer, Councilors Kelma Burch, Rick Griem, Aron White and Jim Kreutzer. Also present were City Superintendent Blaine Medina, Susannah Louderbaugh, Rob Taylor, and Nikki Bjurstrom. City Attorney Charles Moser was absent.

Mayor Kreutzer opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

J. Kreutzer moved K. Burch seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

The Consent Agenda items included: a. June 15, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes, b. June 18, 2026 Special Meeting Minutes, c. Payroll warrants \$36,752.73, d. Accounts Payable warrants \$375,394.71. (The warrants were available for review).

J. Kreutzer moved Meyer seconded to approve the consent agenda items a-d. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Kreutzer opened the floor for public comments. There were no comments.

Burch moved J. Kreutzer seconded for the approval of Lewis, Hooper & Dick's 2026 Audit and Budget Engagement Agreements. Motion carried unanimously.

White moved Burch seconded to move the August 17, 2026 regular scheduled city council meeting to August 24, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

J. Kreutzer moved Meyer moved to approve Ordinance 2026-09 ALLOWING CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR WITHIN SPECIALLY DESIGNATED AREAS AND TIMES DURING THE WICHITA COUNTY FAIR ON JULY 29 TO AUGUST 1, 2026, PURSUANT TO A TEMPORARY PERMIT. Motion carried unanimously.

White moved Burch to approve payment to Sporer Land Development Inc. of \$125,575.00 for the BCBS Pathways Lighted Crosswalk project. Motion carried unanimously.

Meyer moved J. Kreutzer to approve payment to Key Equipment & Supply Co. of \$222,900.00 for the Leach Alpha III Sanitation Truck. Motion carried unanimously.

Burch moved Meyer seconded to approve payment to Core & Main of \$7,500.00 for Sensus meter re-integration update. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held on the City grant writer contract and it was determined that a billing error occurred.

J. Kreutzer moved Meyer seconded that the overpayment under the contract will be deducted from future billings. 4 years, Griem abstained. Motion carried.

City Superintendent Blaine Medina reported we received the new trash truck a couple of weeks ago and is working great. The city crew took over twelve loads of tree branches out to the landfill after the high winds came through. The city crew will be starting to paint the parking stripes on south Highway 25 along with handicap parking for the city and county.

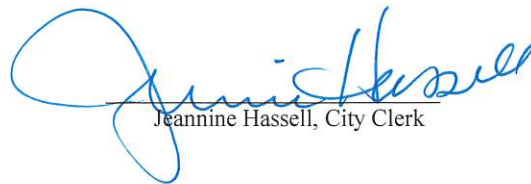
