Mayor Cheryl Green called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Green asked City Clerk Ashley Woods for Role Call; Councilors Amanda Baker, Roger Porter, Ken Farr and Charlie Hughes, City Attorney Becky Faurot, Interim City Superintendent Joel Landis and City Clerk Ashley Woods were present. Baker moved, Farr seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a potential city employee for 5 minutes with Council and Mayor. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 7:44 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Baker moved, Hughes seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employees for 15 minutes with Council, Mayor and City Clerk. Motion carried unanimously. City Clerk Woods returned from executive session at 7:48 p.m. Meeting resumed at 8:01 p.m. Farr moved, Porter seconded to give all full-time and part-time staff a VISA gift card for a Christmas Bonus. Motion carried unanimously.

Porter moved, Baker seconded for adjournment at 8:02 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
