AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LEOTI CODE CHAPTER 28, ARTICLE II, DIVISION 5, SECTION 28-155 SIGNS REQUIRED TO REMOVE STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF SECOND AND J STREETS, AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIRST AND L STREETS; AND REMOVE THE EAST/WEST STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF THIRD AND J STREETS.

WHEREAS, the City has authority to regulate traffic within its city limits and the City desires to do such to protect the health and welfare of its inhabitants.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas:

That Chapter 28, Article II, Division 5, Section 28-155 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Leoti, Kansas, shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 28-155 - Signs Required

Stop signs and yield signs shall be installed at the following street intersections within the city, towit:

- (1) The Intersection of Third and J Streets stopping north-bound and south-bound traffic on Third Street.
- (2) The intersection of Third Street and M Street stopping north-bound and south-bound traffic Third Street traffic.
- (3) The intersection of Wichita and H Streets stopping east-bound H Street traffic.
- (4) The intersection of First and J Streets stopping east-bound and west-bound J Street traffic,
 - (5) The intersection of Wyoming and M Streets stopping east-bound and west-bound M Street traffic.
 - (6) The intersection of Seventh and Earl Streets stopping north-bound and south-bound Seventh Street traffic.

 - (8). The intersection of Wyoming and H Streets stopping north-bound Wyoming traffic,

- Throw's visible of (10). The intersection of Indian Road and H Streets yielding south-bound Indian Road traffic to north-bound Indian Road traffic.
