

ORDINANCE # 2026-03

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BAN OF OPEN BURNING IN THE CITY OF LEOTI

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas, determined that extremely dry conditions exist in the county and the City of Leoti, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas, determined that due to the dryness, the potential for uncontrollable fires exist; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas want to prevent the destruction of property, buildings and life,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas hereby bans open burning. Open burning means any outdoor fire, including, but not limited to, burning of trash, burning of grass, yard waste, or campfires, warming fires, and burn pits. This Ordinance shall be in effect from the date of execution until such time as it is modified or rescinded by the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas.

The governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas hereby declare that it shall be unlawful to violate this Ordinance and that any person found to be guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be fined in amount up to \$2,500.00.


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication once in the official County newspaper.
